Uniform

Arriving for Breakfast Club or School

We have noticed that a few people are starting to arrive a little too early. As a reminder,

breakfast club is not open to take children until 8am and the buzzer will not be answered before then. Children coming to school can access the grounds from 8.45am when the gate unlocks. Please do not buzz to get in before that or follow a member of staff in. The teachers need this precious time in the morning to get ready and may not be in their classrooms.

Parents' Evenings

Next week we are holding the first parent consultation meetings of the school year. We are trying a new system which we have 'borrowed' from another school to avoid running late. At the end of each 10 minute ap-



pointment, a bell will be rung to indicate that you need to end your conversations and leave this situation, the resident has reported the incident the room. We do not intend this to seem rude, but we also know how frustrating it is when we are running very late. Hopefully this will minimise lateness. If you feel you need longer than 10 minutes to discuss an issue, you need to make an appointment with the teacher to come back at another, mutually convenient time.
