

Exciting developments / Staffing updates

For those of you that were unable to attend the two Federation meetings held recently, I have added some of the points that were discussed regarding staffing. I've also included some exciting Stedham developments.

Further Stedham developments:

- Early next year new boilers will be installed
- The attic area will be made into a work area for staff to complete PPA and operate as a quiet area for them
- A survey is about to complete for the installation of solar panels
- The play equipment will be replaced in the spring term
- The play area will have the markings refurbished
- The picnic tables will be replaced
- The EYFS external area will be refreshed, that is partially complete
- Re-painting of the school will be completed
- LED lighting has been installed

Future Staffing:

- Today we interviewed for a 3 day a week office person to operate with Rachel. They will overlap on Wednesdays
- We are recruiting a member of staff to replace the Janice Helas position, a full time person for interventions and class cover for year 2,3 and 4 (this is a registration group with Yr2 being taught separately in all mornings) and a half time TA. The adverts are out for the start of the Spring term.

Current Staffing:

- With two members of staff currently off ill we are going through the sickness processes.
- The process involves:
 - The use of supply teachers which we have agreements for as long a period as is possible given the sickness legal processes.
 - Once the sickness process gives us prognoses West Sussex Occupational Health will provide these – we can arrange better security of staff.
 - o Of course the staff are free to return as and when they are well enough to do so.


