to get our thinking hats on and


investigate all sorts of exciting and pioneering inventions and designs

Literacy

In literacy this half term, we are looking at the amazing picture book called Stanley's Stick. This brilliant story is all about a little boy who imagines his stick is all sorts of things, from a rocket ship to a musical instrument, the book follow Stanley and he and his stick go on some funny adventures. In Rabbits, we will be ordering the story, writing some paragraphs and then designing our own story based on the book.

It's been such a pleasure to see the progress that children have made in writing this term. We were looking at the difference between the first page in their literacy book and the most recent page and WOW! What a difference! Next time you're in for a welcome Wednesday, please do have a glance at your child's book as it will blow you away!

In the reading aspect of Literacy- we will continue to follow the Phonics Bug Club and will read 1-1 with the children once a week (sometimes more) in school. Please do make sure you try and find some time to read with your child at home and don't forget you can log in to the Bug Club online and get the program to read to your child, which hopefully takes some of pressure off!

Maths

In maths we are continuing our investigation into number and are going to look at comparing numbers as well as becoming increasingly confident counting forwards and backwards. We will also look at some shapes and measurement.

Science

In science, we are looking at materials and their features. We have been on a material treasure hunt and will look at what materials would be best to build a house from to protect ourselves from the big bad wolf. We will look at the properties of matierals and how we can describe them using adjectives.

History

In History, we are looking at the history of toys and how they've changed over the years. We will look at photographs from old toys (although looking at the resources, what they classify as 'old' toys, are toys I remember playing with!)

PE

Pe will continue to happen twice a week in Rabbits class- once by our brand new experts from Aspire and once from us following the real PE planning. We have lots of exciting games and activities planned in this area for this half term!

Art

In art we will be making robot sculpts to fit in with our topic. I will send a dojo out soon as we will need everyone to bring in a toilet roll to help make this a success!

I will be contacting parents of reception children over the next few weeks for a catch up and progress checker on your child, so look out for that!
