Summer is almost here and that means more outside activities such as Cricket, Rounders and Tennis!

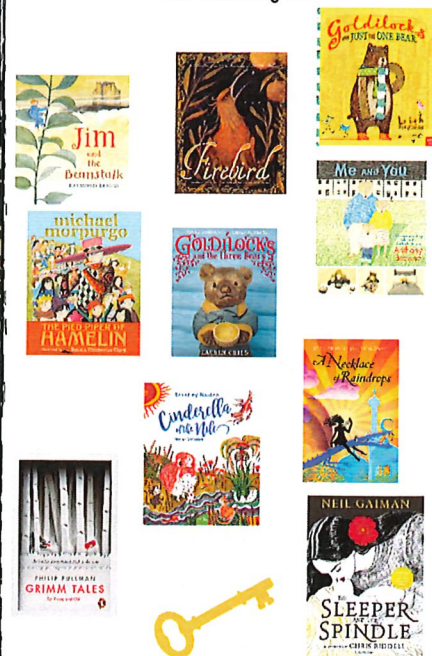
Emphasis this term will be online safety, including cyber bullying and other issues.
