

SPORTS DAY – Friday 5th July at Stedham Sports Field

Dear Parents,

Sports Day is fast approaching. This year we have decided to do things slightly differently after the success last year of holding the event in the morning. The plan is that you bring the children directly to Stedham Sports Field (please ask if you're not sure where it is) between 9 and 9.15am. Any children in breakfast club will be walked down with a member of staff. The children will be registered and organised into their teams, with the aim of starting at 9.30am.

The first part of the morning will be a 'round robin' of 8 activities to challenge your children using skills such as throwing, jumping and aiming. The children will achieve points for the activities which will contribute to the overall team score. After a short refreshment break we shall commence the races, rounding off with a race for pre-schoolers.

Lunch

We think we will probably complete all the races between 11.30 and 12.00. We are then going to have a whole school and family picnic lunch, to which you are all invited. The school kitchen will be closed on this day meaning everyone will need a packed lunch and drink, so please cancel any KS2 hot lunches booked for this date.

If your child is eligible for free school meals and you cannot provide them with a packed lunch yourself, please come and talk to us.

At the end of the picnic, around 1pm, you will have the choice of taking the children home early, or they can walk back to school with us and remain there until they are collected as usual at 3.30pm.

Plan B

This event will of course only happen if the weather is dry. We shall make a decision as to whether or not we go ahead based on the weather forecast. If we have to postpone to our reserve day (Friday 12th July) I shall notify you all by text, the afternoon of











Thursday 4th July. If the event is postponed, the children will all still need their packed lunch as the kitchen will be closed.

Please bring rugs or picnic chairs to sit on while you enjoy the activities. If anyone has a gazebo that they are able to bring and erect for the children to sit under, that would be appreciated. There will be some parking on the field **if the weather is dry**.
